This Notice of default and imminent liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland supersedes and suspends any correspondence from the Respondents/Libellees, none of which is of any substance. Until some superior fact or law is on the record, said correspondence is deemed void for vagueness under colour of law, and has been deemed insufficient response according to the contract: **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland.**

Notice of default

You are hereby noticed that you are in **default** of an opportunity to respond to the contract: **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, received by you on 21 July 2020 with an effective date of 4 August 2020; and in **default** of an opportunity to cure as lawfully offered in the **Notice of Fault and opportunity to cure liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, received by you on 24 August 2020 with an effective date of 7 September 2020;

In correction and clarification for the record, you were given the opportunity to:

1. **State a claim** as stated in the section; **Offer of Immunity—Stating a Claim** of the said contract: **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland.**
2. **Remain silent** and agree with all terms of the said contract: **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland.**

Due to failure of Respondents/Libellees to answer with a specific, verified, and sworn response to the instant contract: **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, a **default judgment** is hereby issued against Respondents/Libellees. Having waived the right to answer and by failure to contest, you have rejected your due process opportunity.

In the absence of such verified response, the Claimant/Libellant does hereby insert and record this Notice of default and imminent liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland, jointly and severally as appropriate upon and against the above named Respondent(s)/Libellee(s).

Invoices and statements connected with the contract, **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland.** are issued and adjusted to reflect subsequent and anticipated infractions by Respondents/Libellees.

PLAIN STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. An offer regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland. was made by the Respondents/Libellees.
2. On 21 July 2020, the Respondents/Libellees received the contract: **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, delivered by Royal Mail Signed For Service.
3. Respondents/Libellees were given the opportunity, with specific terms, to respond to the said contract within a reasonable time frame.
4. The effective date was 4 August 2020.
5. No substantive responses were received according to the terms of the contract, **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**.
6. On 24 August 2020 the Respondents/Libellees received the **Notice of fault and opportunity to cure liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**.
7. The effective date to cure the fault was 7 September 2020.
8. No substantive responses to the **Notice of fault and opportunity to cure liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland** were received according to the terms of the contract: **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**.
9. This lawful administrative process, including the **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, the **Notice of fault and opportunity to cure liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, and this instant **Notice of default and imminent liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, all jointly constitute the “meeting of the minds” requirement on the original contract offer made by Respondents/Libellees, and others yet to be named (see EXHIBIT A of the **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**).
10. **Regarding Respondents/Libellees’ offer regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**; the offer, the meeting of the minds, and the conditional acceptance have all been clearly expressed.
11. Respondents/Libellees have failed to respond, and are in default, and in dishonour of the Contract, **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, as expressed therein and are subject to any and all of the terms therein.
12. Failure to meet the requirements as clearly defined in the section, **Insufficiency of Response** in the **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**. does hereby constitute, as an operation of law, the **FINAL** admission and agreement of the liability of Respondents/Libellees as stated in the **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, and the Respondents/Libellees’ contract is hereby binding and is deemed *stare decisis*.
13. Such actions shall be taken in accordance to the procedures, jurisdictions, and penalties thereof set forth in the **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of**

of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland as defaulted.
