Notice of fault.

You are hereby noticed that you are in fault of an opportunity to respond to the **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, received by you on 21 July 2020 with an effective date of 4 August 2020.

In correction and clarification for the record, you were given the opportunity to:

1. **State a claim** as stated in the section; **Offer of Immunity—Stating a Claim** of the said **Offer and Notice of liability acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**.
2. **Remain silent** and agree with all terms of the said **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**.

Due to Respondent/Libellee's failure to answer with a specific, verified, and sworn response to the instant contract, **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland** received by you on 21 July 2020, a **default judgement** is being sought by Claimant/Libellant against Respondent/Libellee, said Respondent/Libellee having waived the right to answer, and failed to contest, thereby relinquishing Respondent/Libellee's due process opportunity.

In absence of such verified response, the Claimant/Libellant does hereby insert and record this **Notice of fault and opportunity to cure liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland** upon and against the above named Respondent/Libellees.

Plain statement of facts.

1. On 21 July 2020 the Respondent/Libellee received the contract, **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**, delivered by Royal Mail Signed For Service.
2. Respondent/Libellee was given the opportunity, with specific terms, to respond to the said contract within a reasonable time frame.
3. The effective date is 4 August 2020.
4. No responses were received according to the terms of the **Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**.
5. As of the effective date, Respondent/Libellee has failed to respond, and is in fault, and in dishonour of the **Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland** and are subject to any and all of the terms therein.

Opportunity to cure

the event that the Respondent/Libellee's failure to accept the remedy offered in the **Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland** was an oversight, mistake, or otherwise unintentional, Claimant/Libellant demonstrates his abundant goodwill by granting Respondent/Libellee fourteen (14) days from the date of receipt of this Notice to cure the fault and effect the remedy.

Failure to cure will constitute, as an operation of law, the **Final** admission and agreement of the liability of Respondent/Libellee as stated in the **Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland** and the contract shall be deemed *stare decisis*.

Such actions shall be taken in accordance to the procedures, jurisdictions, and penalties thereof set forth in the **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland** as defaulted.

In particular, you now have the opportunity to **deny** that you own money according to the attached Statement of Account. Failure to do so is your agreement that the money is owed by you. Denial can only be made by complying with the terms of the contract: **Offer and Notice of liability regarding acting in the capacity of an officer of of an organisation purporting to have business in Shetland**. You are reminded that not complying with the terms of said contract makes you forever barred from your future denial.
